The East Staffordshire District Council (Edgehill, Stapenhill, Burton-upon-Trent) Smoke Control (No. 10) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the East Staffordshire District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, as amended, propose to make an Order entitled The East Staffordshire District Council (Edgehill, Stapenhill, Burton-upon-Trent) Smoke Control (No. 10) Order, 1988, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be

The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels gas and electricity.
