THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 11) SCHEME 1989

Made Coming into operation 1st March 1989 3rd April 1989

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1968 and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme.

Commencement and citation

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 3rd April 1989 and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 11) Scheme 1989.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Scheme 1982 (Post Office Scheme P3/1982) (hereinaster called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1983 (Post Office Scheme P2/1983), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1984 (Post Office Scheme 4/1984), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1985 (Post Office Scheme 3/1985), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1985 (Post Office Scheme 5/1985), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1986 (Post Office Scheme 1/1986), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 6) Scheme 1986 (Post Office Scheme 3/1986), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 7) Scheme 1986 (Post Office Scheme 7/1986), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1987 (Post Office Scheme 1/1987), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 9) Scheme 1987 (Post Office Scheme 3/1987) and the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 10) Scheme 1988 (Post Office Scheme 1/1988).

Interpretation

- 2.—(1) In paragraph 3(1) of the Scheme as subsequently amended:
- (a) the definition of "air parcel" shall be deleted;
- (b) the following definitions shall be inserted after the definition of 'customs duty'
- ""Economy Service" means a service provided in respect of an outgoing parcel intended by the sender to be conveyed so as to arrive at its destination later than if it were sent as a Standard Service parcel:
- "Economy Service parcel" means a parcel sent by the Economy Service;"
- (c) The following definitions shall be inserted after the definition
 - of "prescribed":
 ""Standard Service" means a service provided in respect of
 an outgoing parcel which (if Economy Service is available) is intended by the sender to be conveyed so as to arrive at its destination sooner than if it were sent as an Economy Service
 - "Standard Service parcel" means a parcel sent by the Standard Service;"
- (2) The following sub-paragraph shall be inserted between subparagraphs (1) and (2) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme:
 - "(1A) In Part 1 of Schedule 1, the following expressions used in relation to a parcel have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - "to Zone 1" means addressed to a country or place specified in Part 2 of Schedule 1;
 - "to Zone 2" means addressed to a country or place specified in Part 3 of Schedule 1;
 - "to Zone 3" means addressed to a country or place specified in Part 4 of Schedule 1;
 - "to Zone 4" means addressed to a country or place specified in Part 5 of Schedule 1:
 - "to Zone 5" means addressed to a country or place specified in Part 6 of Schedule 1;
 - "to Zone 6" means addressed to a country or place specified in Part 7 of Schedule 1;
 - "to Zone 7" means addressed to a country or place specified in Part 8 of Schedule 1."

Rates of Postage

3. In paragraph 5(2) of the Scheme, the words "(other than those sent by Standard Service)" shall be substituted for the words "(other than air parcels)".

Unpaid or Underpaid Postage

4. In paragraph 13(1) of the Scheme, the words "(including a Standard Service parcel)" shall be substituted for the words "(including an air parcel)".

5. Paragraph 18 of the Scheme shall be deleted and the following inserted in its place:

"Standard Service parcels

18.—(1) A parcel to be sent as a Standard Service parcel shall bear a "Standard Service" label affixed close to the address (or to each place where the address appears, if the parcel is addressed in more than one place).

(2) A parcel shall be transmissible as a Standard Service parcel only if it is addressed to any such country or place as may from time to time be prescribed."

Express delivery

6. In paragraph 20 of the Scheme, "£1.50" shall read "£1.90".

Delivery free of charges

7. In sub-paragraph (1)(b) of paragraph 22 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, "70p" shall read "90p".

Advice of delivery (outgoing insured parcels only) enquiries and claims for compensation

8. In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 26 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, "21p" shall read "30p".

Parcels in bond

9. In sub-paragraph (7)(c)(ii) of paragraph 27 of the Scheme, "an air mail parcel" shall read "a Standard Service parcel".
