Made 21st March 1995<br>Coming into operation 3rd April 1995

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

## Commencement and citation

1. (i) This Scheme shall come into operation on 3rd April 1995 and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 17) Scheme 1995.

3. In sub-paragraph (3)(a) of paragraph 21 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, " 3.00 " shall read " 3.10 ".

## Compensation

4. Subparagraph (15) of paragraph 24 of the Scheme shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:
"(25) No compensation may be paid in respect of an insured parcel for the loss or damage of:
(a) hazardous goods or prohibited/restricted items
(b) diamonds and other precious stones
(c) real fur
(d) jewellery (any ornament of dress containing precious metal and/or precious stones, including costume jewellery, valued over $£ 100$ per item/pair.
(e) watches
(f) articles made largely or wholly of gold, silver or other precious metals
(g) negotiable documents
(h) antiques and collectabies (objects which have appreciated in value due to circumstances such as scarcity, workmanship, beauty, age of due to the object being no longer in production).
(i) airline tickets
(j) money, meaning all or any of the following:

- Any bank note or currency note, being current in the British postal area or elsewhere.
- Coins.
- Any uncrossed postal order which does not state to whom it is to be paid.
- Any cheque or dividend warrant which is uncrossed and made payable to bearer.
- Any bearer security (including a share warrant, scrip or subscription certificate, bond or relative coupon).
- Any unobliterated postage or revenue stamp valid for current use in the British postal area or elsewhere (except a revenue stamp embossed or impressed on an instrument which has been executed).
- Any coupon, voucher, token, card, stamp or similar document which can be exchanged (by itself or with any other document) for money, goods or services.
- National Insurance stamps".


## Parcels in bond

5. (i) In sub-paragraph $5(\mathrm{~b})$ of paragraph 27 of the scheme as subsequently amended " f 1.10 " shall read 4.75
(ii) A sub-paragraph (c) of sub-paragraph (5) of paragraph 27 shall be added as follows:
"(c) for each parcel stored for a period of 20 working days or more, an additional fee of $£ 1.10$ per parcel for each additional working day".
