- (2) The purpose and effect of these modifications to the electricity distribution licences is to put in place, from 1st April 2000, a process by which the allowed income of each licensee may be adjusted to enable the full recovery of payments made by the licensee to the Authority in accordance with the standard licence condition entitled 'Payments by Licensee to the Authority' and of payments made by the predecessor company of the licence holder to the Director General of Electricity Supply under the licence condition entitled 'Payment of fees'.
- (3) A copy of the proposed modification can be obtained (free of charge) from the Office of Gas and Electricity Markets ("Ofgem"), 9 Millbank, London SW1P 3GE, and will be available also on the Ofgem website (www.ofgem.gov.uk) for a period of 28 days from the date of this Notice. Consignia plc<sup>(a)</sup> by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 89 of the Postal Services Act 2000 and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

#### Commencement and citation

- 1.-(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 2nd January 2002 and may be cited as the Consignia plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 3) Scheme 2002.
- (2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Successor Postal Services Company Overseas Parcel Post Scheme 2001<sup>(b)</sup> (hereinafter called "the Scheme"), as amended by the Consignia plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 1) Scheme 2001<sup>(c)</sup> and the Consignia plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 2) Scheme 2001<sup>(d)</sup>

#### Prohibitions

- (d) an infectious substance which may be categorised in risk groups 1, 2 or 3 in accordance with Schedule 3 to the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 1999(e):
- (e) a shotgun or air weapon which is exempted from the requirement for a firearm certificate by section 1(3) of the Firearms Act 1968<sup>(f)</sup> may at the discretion of Consignia be accepted for posting provided that the parcel is posted in accordance with the conditions of this Scheme and complies with the packaging requirements specified in sub-paragraph (2B) below.
- (2B) Any item referred to in paragraph (2A) above shall only be posted in a parcel if it has been packed in accordance with the packaging requirements for that item required by-
- (a) the postal administration in the country of destination;
- (b) the postal administration in any country through which the parcel maybe sent; and
- (c) Consignia

Provided that Consignia's packaging requirements are contained in this Scheme, the Parcelforce Worldwide Customer Charter and Code of Practice and the Parcelforce Worldwide Guide to Services."
