## Notice under Article 14 (3) of the Gas (Northern Ireland) Order 1996

The Northern Ireland Authority for Energy Regulation (hereinafter referred to as "the Authority") in accordance with Article 14(3) of the Gas (Northern Ireland) Order 1996, as amended, (the "Order") hereby gives notice as follows:

1. The Authority proposes, pursuant to its power under Article 14(1)(a) of the Order, to make modifications to conditions contained in 'Part 4, The Price Control Conditions' of the licence granted under Article 8(1)(a) of the Order (the "licence") to Bord Gais Eireann (the "licensee"), as subsequently assigned to BGE (NI) Distribution Ltd.
2. The reasons for, and the effects of, the proposed modifications are as follows:

## Reasons

The majority of the proposed modifications are being made to correct minor drafting errors in Part 4, The Price Control Conditions, including certain amendments to the formulae subscripts.
The modification to the definition of 'formulae year' is required to ensure that the period of the formulae year is the same as the period of the regulatory reporting year and the licensee's financial year. The Authority believes that aligning the relevant periods will make it easier to make comparisons of regulatory determination and regulatory accounts and also reduce the costs of reporting.
The modification relating to the disapplication process is required to ensure that any reference made by the Authority to the Competition Commission following a disapplication request is reference relating to the core price control formulae.
The modification relating to the disaggregation of the conveyance categories into six demand bands is required for information and price control purposes and will enable the Authority to better analyse cost allocations and compare performance with other licensees.

## Effect

The proposed modifications will -
(a) Correct the drafting errors.
(b) Change the disapplication process such that any reference to the Competition Commission will be in respect of the constraint conditions.
(c) Change the formula year so that it aligns with the regulatory reporting year and BGE's financial year.
(d) Expand the conveyance categories from four demand bands to six demand bands.

## Commencement and citation

1. This Scheme shall come into operation on 26 September 2005 and may be cited as the Royal Mail Group plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No.9) Scheme 2005.
2. This Scheme shall be read as one with the Successor Postal Services Company Overseas Parcel Post Scheme $2001{ }^{(c)}$ (hereinafter called "the Scheme"), as amended by the Consignia plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 1) Scheme $2001{ }^{(d)}$, the Consignia plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 2) Scheme $2001{ }^{(\mathrm{e})}$, the Consignia plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 3) Scheme $2002{ }^{(f)}$, the Consignia plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 4) Scheme $2002{ }^{(\mathrm{g})}$, the Royal Mail Group plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 5) Scheme 2003 ${ }^{(h)}$, the Royal Mail Group plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 6) $2003{ }^{\text {(i) }}$, the Royal Mail Group plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 7) $2003{ }^{(\mathrm{j})}$ and the Royal Mail Group plc Overseas Parcel Post (Amendment No. 8) 2004 ${ }^{(\mathrm{k})}$.
3. A reference in this Scheme to the Successor Postal Services Company shall be read as a reference to Royal Mail Group plc.
