EARLY POSTING.

In view of the restricted number of postal collections and deliveries, and the depletion of the postal staff, LETTERS SHOULD BE POSTED AS EARLY IN THE DAY as possible. In many rural districts there is only one delivery, and letters for such districts, unless posted in time for early evening mails, cannot be delivered until the second day after posting.

TELEGRAPH BUSINESS.

Restricted hours for telegraph business—see pages 135 and 136 of the July Guide—have been introduced at a number of offices since that Guide went to press. For particulars see pages 7 and 8 to 25.

DELIVERY OF TELEGRAMS.

The special attention of senders and addressees of telegrams is drawn to the arrangements described at page 87 and 88 of the July Guide for the delivery of telegrams by telephone.

The Post Office Guide (price 6d.) and the periodical Supplement (price 3d.) can be purchased at any Post Office, through any bookseller, or from the Branches and Agency of H.M. Stationery Office shown on the other side.

(Page 11.) PRINTED PAPERS.

From the heading "Circulars" *delete* the words "printed visiting cards, Christmas, New Year, Easter and birthday cards," and underneath *insert* the following:—

<p>Printed Christmas, New Year, Easter, birthday, picture, greeting and visiting cards.</p>	<p>That nothing appear in writing except:—</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Date and names and addresses of sender and addressee. (2) Formulas of courtesy or of a conventional character not exceeding five words or initials.

(Page 12.)

From the footnote commencing "Circulars" *delete* condition (d), and underneath the paragraph commencing "Circulars wholly or partly printed in imitation of typewriting" *add* a fresh paragraph:—

No documents printed or reproduced in imitation of typewriting are admissible at the Inland Printed Paper Rate except circulars. The copies must be identical (that is, they may not bear in writing anything other than the date of the circular and the names, addresses and descriptions of sender and addressee).

(Page 13.)

In the third paragraph, last line, before the words "the Letter Rate," *insert* "the Post-card Rate if admissible at that rate, or at."

(Page 18.)

PROHIBITED ARTICLES.

Delete paragraph (c) and *substitute* the following:—

(c) any advertisement of a Betting House at home or abroad.

(Page 36.)

EXPRESS DELIVERY SERVICES.

SERVICE III.—By Special Delivery in advance of the ordinary Mail at the request of the Addressee.

In the fourth paragraph, seventh line, *delete* "penny" and *substitute* "threehalfpenny."

(Page 37.)

CONVEYANCE OF SINGLE POST LETTERS BY RAILWAY.

From the first paragraph, fourth line, *delete* "1 ounce" and *substitute* "4 ounces."

(Page 39.)

Letters excluded from transmission as Railway Letters.

From the paragraph lettered (a) *delete* "1 ounce" and *substitute* "4 ounces."

**Combination of Express Service and Railway Service
(Week-days only).**

From the first line of the first paragraph *delete* "1 ounce" and *substitute* "4 ounces."

(Page 44.)

SPECIAL DELIVERY.

At the end of the first paragraph *delete* "10s. 6d. a year or £1 1s." and *substitute* "15s. a year or 30s."

(Page 45.)

Delivery at Another Address.

From the second line *delete* "£1 1s." and *substitute* "30s."

(Page 47.)

PREPAYMENT IN MONEY.

Delete paragraph 2. *Substitute the following* :—

It is a great advantage to the Post Office to receive these special postings, especially when in large numbers, early in the day. At all the London Offices mentioned in the previous paragraph correspondence to be prepaid in money must be presented at the counters between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. At Provincial towns the hours of posting are from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

SAMPLES.

Special Regulations as to Certain Articles.

After paragraph 2 the following should be inserted :— **Samples of Tea** not exceeding 8 oz. in gross weight can be imported, provided that the packets are plainly marked as containing tea. Each packet, exceeding 2 oz. in weight, is liable to a charge of 3d. Customs Duty. Packets of tea exceeding 8 oz. in gross weight, and sent by Sample Post from abroad, are liable to forfeiture by the Customs.

(Page 62.)

PARCELS.**Customs Duty and Charges on Delivery.***Insert* before "All parcels are liable to be opened . . .":—**Parcels from Places Abroad for Delivery in the United Kingdom.**

Every parcel received from a place abroad is subject to examination by the British Customs; and those containing dutiable articles are liable to charges calculated in accordance with the British Customs tariff for the time being in force. Except in the case of *ad valorem* duties and the specific duties on cinematograph films, such charges are collected by the Post Office on behalf of the Commissioners of Customs and Excise, and must be paid to the postman before the parcels are handed over to the addressee. A fee of 2d., for clearance through the Customs, is charged on every such parcel.

Any application in regard to British Customs charges raised on parcels from a place abroad should be addressed to the Customs Surveyor at the town indicated in the date-stamp impression on the charge label (F. & C.P.P. No. 6 or F. & C.P.P. No. 19) affixed to the parcel, and should be accompanied by that portion of the cover bearing the address and the charge labels.

UNDELIVERED CORRESPONDENCE.

Delete the first paragraph:—"Undelivered postal packets of all kinds . . . to the postage originally payable," and *substitute the following*:—

"Letters, Post-cards, Printed and Commercial Papers and Samples.

Undelivered correspondence of these kinds returned to this country from places abroad is, as a general rule, disposed of in the same manner as undelivered inland correspondence on which the same amounts of postage are chargeable (*see page 24 in July Guide*). Packets sent to Canada and Newfoundland by Magazine Post are charged on return with further postage equal to the postage originally payable."

(Page 79.)

INTERNATIONAL EXPRESS SERVICE.**General Correspondence.**

Delete "Algeria" and "France" from the list of countries participating in the International Express Service.

INLAND TELEGRAMS.**(Page 88.) Delivery by Telephone.**

Add to first paragraph:—No charge is made to a subscriber for recording instructions for the delivery by telephone from the normal delivery office of his fully addressed telegrams.

(Page 90.) Registered Abbreviated Addresses.

Add to second paragraph:—A fee of one shilling is charged for recording a change of address but the record may be cancelled and the original address resumed without further charge.

Add to third paragraph:—No charge is made to a registrant for recording instructions for the delivery by telephone of telegrams bearing his registered address.

(Page 91.) Redirection.

Paragraph 1. Line 6. Add after "Postmaster":—If telegrams bearing a registered address are to be redirected as well as fully addressed telegrams a second fee of one shilling must be paid.

Lines 9 and 10. After "within the same town" continue as follows:—but if the addresses are in different towns the full inland rate is charged for the redirection of fully addressed telegrams.

POSTAL ORDERS.**(Page 118.) Places of Issue and Payment.**

Insert Palestine (occupied districts) in its proper place in the list.

(Page 143.)**INSURANCE STAMPS.**

Lines 2 and 3. From the list of denominations delete 1d., 1½d., 2d. and 3½d.

Line 10. Cancel the third and fourth denominations after "Scotland." The denominations now on sale in England, Wales and Scotland are 7s. 7d. and 6s. 6d.

(Pages 146-148.)**PROVINCIAL OFFICES IN THE UNITED KINGDOM.**

Particulars shown against an entry in the subjoined list of Amendments supersede those appearing against the corresponding entry in the list given at pages 149 to 509 of the July issue of the Post Office Guide. The list includes the names of the Offices at which the hours of Telegraph business have been changed since the July Guide went to press. The arrangement of the list is as stated on pages 146-148 of the July

issue. **The hours of Telegraph business are, unless otherwise stated in the third column, the ordinary hours, i.e., 9.0 a.m. to 7 p.m. Week Days, and 8.30 a.m. to 10.0 a.m. Sundays.**

Offices which have been closed since the July Guide was printed are denoted by the words "Office closed" in the third column of this list.

(Exceptional hours for Telegraph business.)

Offices open on Sunday evenings are also open on Bank Holidays during the same hours, unless otherwise indicated.
