Eggs, Fish, Game (including Rabbits), Meat, Fruit, and Vegetables can be sent by Parcel Post only.

First paragraph. *Insert*: "Luxembourg" after "Italy" in the list of Countries participating in the Insured Box Service.

### INLAND TELEGRAMS.

Messages telegraphed for Inclusion in Outgoing Mails.

Telegrams may be sent to certain ports for onward transmission as letters. The sender must write "post" (which will not be charged for) before the addressee's name and the name of the terminal Telegraph Office at the end of the address. For example: "Post, Brown, 12, Fifth Avenue, New York, Liverpool." Thus a telegram of 24 words to be sent by post from Liverpool to New York should be prepaid 1s. 5d., *viz.*, 1s. 3½d. for the telegram (including ½d. for the name of Liverpool) and 1½d. for postage. In such cases a registered address cannot be used.

**Miscellaneous Regulations.***Cancel* the fourth paragraph, and *substitute* the following :—

The name and address of the sender of a telegram, if not to be telegraphed, should be written on the back of the form, so that in the event of non-delivery the sender may be advised.

**FOREIGN AND COLONIAL TELEGRAMS.**

*Delete* the first paragraph, *i.e.* from "All telegrams" down to "their disposal."

*Delete* the section headed "Plain language; Code language." *Substitute* the following :—

**Plain language; Code language; Cypher.**

Telegrams are accepted without restriction to most places abroad. A few countries, however, still maintain restrictions, of which particulars may be obtained at any Post Office.

(Page 96.)

*Delete* the first four paragraphs, *i.e.* from "Telegrams written ..." down to "... are prohibited."

**(Page 97.) Addresses of Telegrams.**

*Delete* the first four paragraphs, *i.e.* from "Telegrams should ..." down to "... charged for," and *substitute* a paragraph as follows :—

The address must be paid for, and must in no case consist of less than two words. When it is expressed in two words, the first should designate the addressee, and the second should be the name of the telegraph office of destination. Such abbreviated addresses should be registered at the office of destination.

(Page 98.)

*Delete* the third paragraph, *i.e.* from "All telegrams ..." down to "paid for."

**Prepaid Replies.†**

*Insert* the words "and North Russia" after "Mesopotamia" in the second line of the first paragraph.

(Page 99.)

**Repetition at Request of Sender to Ensure Accuracy.**

The second paragraph should stand as follows :—

"Repetition is desirable for all telegrams in code or cypher."

**Repetition at Request of Addressee to Detect Errors.**

*Delete* the words "and subject to censorship" after "Delivery Office" in the second line of the first paragraph.

(Page 100.)

**Mixed Postal and Telegraph Service.**

*Delete* the third paragraph, *i.e.* from "Messages cannot be telegraphed" down to "for inclusion in Outgoing Mails."

*Insert* between the paragraphs headed "Special Delivery" and "Telegrams to Follow the Addressee" the following paragraph:—

**Notice of Delivery.**

On payment of an additional rate for five words, the sender may have a notice of the time at which his telegram was delivered transmitted to him by telegraph. In that case "P.C.," which is charged for as one word, must be inserted before the address of destination. The information will be given by post on payment of a fee of 2½*d.*, and of the charge for one additional word for the expression "P.C.P." before the address. This arrangement does not at present apply to telegrams for France and French Possessions, Italy and Italian Possessions, or Turkey.

**Telegrams to be called for.**

*Add* at end of first paragraph:—"Telegrams addressed to a Télégraphe restant are not at present admitted to places in Switzerland."

*Delete* second paragraph, *i.e.*, from "Such telegrams" down to "East Africa."

(Page 103.)

**RADIOTELEGRAMS.**

*Delete* the first paragraph, *i.e.*, from "All Radiotelegrams" to "Foreign Telegrams."

(Paragraph 3.) **Private Radiotelegrams.**

*Delete* "Mediterranean" from the list of waters for which private radiotelegrams are not accepted.

**FOREIGN AND COLONIAL MONEY ORDERS.****Rates of Poundage.**

*Insert* after "Japan, etc.," in section (a), and before "Portugal":—"Palestine and Syria."

Particulars shown against an entry in the subjoined list of Amendments supersede those appearing against the corresponding entry in the list given at pages 149 to 509 of the July issue of the Post Office Guide. The list includes the names of the Offices at which the hours of Telegraph business have been changed since the July Guide went to press. The arrangement of the list is as stated on pages 146–148 of the July issue.

Offices which have been open or closed since the July Guide was printed are denoted by the words "New Office" or "Office closed" in the third column of this list.

**Exceptional hours** for Telegraph business are indicated in the third column.

Offices open on Sunday evenings are also open on Bank Holidays during the same hours, unless otherwise indicated.

The meanings of some of the symbols used are given at the foot of the pages of the List. The others are explained below :—

**D** = General delivery of telegrams.

**nD** = No delivery of telegrams.
