We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) order, direct, and declare as follows :---

1. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Warrant to be Colonial Post Warrant, 1898* (hereinafter called "the Principal read with Warrant") and all Warrants amending the same.

2. The Principal Warrant shall apply to letters transmitted to Application and from Fgypt and The Soudan as if Egypt and The Soudan of Principal Warrant to were specified in the Second Schedule to the said Warrant.

3. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Short title. Post Amendment (No. 12) Warrant, 1905."

4. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 15th day of Commence-December, 1905.
